



Forest Trends and FUNBIO

The Brazilian Biodiversity Fund (Funbio) and Forest Trends have partnered to develop a technical study for the mapping of experiences for **payments environmental services (PES)** and other economic incentives in the **oceans** near Brazil (including coastal and marine environments). The results of this study will serve as inputs for the existing **Brazilian Matrix of Ecosystem Services (PES Matrix)**.

The survey and analysis for the study will last two years, in this first stage, the information that will be part of the Matrix PES for oceans and coastal ecosystems will be included. By understanding that all economic instruments of payments for environmental services are connected, and if treated in an integrated manner, incorporating a column for oceans can strengthen the recommendation of practical actions for decision makers (government officials, investors, providers, payers, etc.), this is following the same logic and methodology of PES Brazil Matrix.

Funbio is a non-profit association that has been operating for 20 years. Funbio has created an innovative private financing mechanism, to develop strategies that contribute to the implementation of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) in Brazil. It works as a strategic partner with the public and private sectors and civil society in order to consolidate conservation policies. Since 2015, Funbio's conservation area has been categorized into three units: International and National Donations National, Legal Obligations and Special Projects, the latter responsible for managing the Matrix PES project.
